



East- Lombok; walk Tetebatu

Tetebatu is a small village on the south slopes of the powerful Rinjani-volcano. Because of its nice situation amidst rice-and tobaccofields this is a favourite startingpoint for strolls around the countryside.

During this tour you visit on the way to Tetebatu a local market where you may buy some fruit or can see the gaudy cidomo's (horse carts) that are so typical of Lombok. From Tetebatu we make a beautiful walk of about three hours. We start in a colonial hotel and walk through clove and-coffeplantations. We continue past rice- and tobaccoterraces. The views of Mount Rinjani and its deep valleys are fantastic. The last part leads through bambooforests and jungle to a spectacular waterfall. This is a nice place to cool off under an iccold shower.

We will be met by our car and transported back to Senggigi in about two hours. If you want you can combine this tour with an hotel in Tetebatu. See our hotellist for offerings.
